Martin Fruhling Memorial Open Horse Show Rules

- Boots with safe riding heels, hat, belt and long sleeve shirts are required. Chaps, hobbles, and riata optional. Silver is not to count over safe, clean equipment.
- Stallions are to be handled by persons 18 years of age or older.
- Novice horse: a horse that has not won three first place pleasure ribbons.
- Horses may be shown in a snaffle bit or curb bit. Martingales are prohibited
- The judge and show management reserves the right to dismiss or disqualify any horse, rider or handler from the arena or premises for dangerous, undesirable behavior, cruelty or cruel use of equipment, profanity, or any un-sportsmanlike conduct.
- Age of rider and horse is as of Jan. 1st of the current year.
- No refund will be given without a veterinarian's or physician's Certificate.
- The judge's decision is final. There will be no contact with the Judge during the show, or while the judge is on the premises, unless at the judge's approval.
- To be eligible for the Martin Fruhling Memorial Trophy, you must be a WWRAC member and ride a registered ApHC Horse.** Call or go to www.wwrac.org for application.

- English classes may be ridden Hunt Seat or Saddle Seat.
- To be eligible for WWRAC Year-End High Point and Club Awards, you must be a member of the WWRAC and meet all Club requirements for High Point. Contact Kris Reiter – HP Committee Chairperson @ (360) 240-1040 for more info.
- You do not have to be a club member in order to be eligible for the Day End High Point Awards. Day-End High Point must be a one horse, one rider combination
- The office will be open for entries at 8:00 a.m.
- No running of horses outside of the arena or warm-up arena will be allowed.
- Ribbons to all in Class #23
- Riders in Classes 23, 24, 25 may not enter any other mounted class except #41 (Costume)
- No horses will be allowed amongst the spectators or in the show office or Concession areas.
- Management reserves the right to combine, cancel, or split classes. Classes with two or less riders may be combined.
- There will be a \$25.00 protest fee.
- No Alcoholic Beverages or non-prescription drugs will be allowed on show grounds.
- All Dogs must be on a leash at all times
- Post entries will close 2 classes prior to requested class.
